

## Intelbras Coordinated Vulnerability Disclosure

**Security Vulnerability in Action RF 1200 and Action RG 1200 Routers – 12/03/24****ID:** INTVUL\_REDES-001

**Summary:** Intelbras Action RF 1200 and Action RG 1200 routers have an authentication flaw that results in login bypass.

**Description of vulnerability:** In Intelbras Action RF 1200 routers, version 1.2.2 and earlier, and Action RG 1200 routers, version 2.1.7 and earlier, during the authentication process, it is possible to intercept the hash of a successful authentication and resend it, achieving successful authentication.

**CVE ID:** CVE-2024-22773

**Risk of the Vulnerability:** 8.1 HIGH CVSS:3.1/AV:N/AC:H/PR:N/UI:N/S:U/C:H/I:H/A:H
